Sound System at Stone

We have a state-of-the-art sound system at Stone, and we want to be able to use it to its full potential. Steve Shantz has experience with operating church sound systems and has offered to do some workshops. There are two groups of people who should attend: *the Users:* those who use the microphones (readers, speakers and preachers) and *the Operators:* those who operate the sound system. The Users will be required to attend a 45 minute workshop after a church service, and the Operators will be also be required to participate in a 2-3 hour workshop. These workshops will happen toward the end of February. Also, in order to ensure continuous quality in the sound we hear at Stone, we need to form a team of sound system Operators who are ready to engage each Sunday and at other events requiring sound at Stone. Storm Policy

Should there be a storm expected on Sunday that would make it difficult for congregants to make it to the church, a service will take place on Saturday at 4:00 pm. Notice of a service change will be emailed out to the parish by Friday evening and those who do not receive email notifications will be called personally. There will still be a pared down 10:30 am service on Sunday morning for those who cannot make the Saturday service or for those that may not know about the cancellation. This service will not have music or coffee hour and will NOT require greeters, lay readers, musicians, counters or anyone who would otherwise be on duty. This will be a simple said service for those who may not have been aware of the cancellation. We hope this will keep everyone safe and allow everyone to have a chance to come together and worship Jesus as a community as we travel through this storm season.
