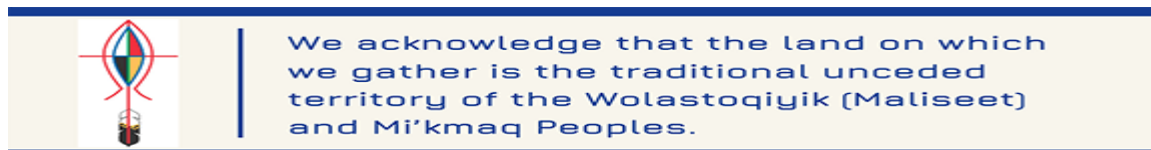

Healing Prayer

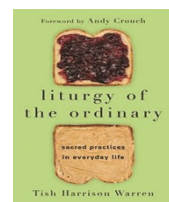
If you would like prayer for healing of any kind, we invite you to come up to the right side of the communion rail at the conclusion of the final hymn and we will have people there to pray for you.

Welcome to Lent

This is a time where we prepare for Easter. We get ready to celebrate the victory of Jesus over the cross and over the grave, but the road we travel to get there is covered by the deep shadow of the crucifixion. Over the next 40 days (+Sundays) we will be invited to draw close to God through reading, reflecting and praying. There may be certain habits or practices that take your time or focus away from God and you may want to consider letting these go during Lent. You may want to give something up so that you can relate (even in a very small way) to the sacrifice Jesus endured for us. Or you may want to take something on - like adding or extending a time of prayer or bible reading in your daily life. We'd also like to invite you to participate in the Lenten Book Discussions or the Faces of Easter Reflections. Whatever you choose to do or not do, may you know how greatly you are loved by God and may this time help us enter more fully into that love.
