### International Anglican-Roman Catholic Accord Moves Forward in Saint John

On Mon., October 1 at 10:30 am at Stone Church there will be an historic signing of an agreed project between the Rt. Rev. Robert Harris, Bishop of Saint John and the Rt. Rev. David Edwards, Bishop of Fredericton to move forward together in mission. This is a direct response to the expressed desires of Pope Francis and Archbishop Justin Welby to have joint ventures in mission, addressing great needs in areas where Anglican and Roman Catholic dioceses overlap across the world. A joint committee was formed last year and has been meeting to present a proposal in Mission which will be adopted at the signing. Church members and other interested persons are invited to be present for the signing.
