We Welcome to our service this morning Mr. Zoel Breau, Director of L'Arche Saint John. L'Arche provides their core members the ability to live their lives in a full and meaningful way, each valued as having a unique contribution to make, participating in the wider community, and growing in friendship.

On Mon., February 3rd we had 79 grade 8 students from Samuel the Champlain come to Stone Church. They went out into the city and had tours of Outflow, the Teen Resource Centre, Romero House, and the Social Enterprise Hub. They also had a catered lunch at the church by Stone Soup Cafe and heard from 7 other non-profits (Coverdale, Inner City Youth, The Food Basket, The John Howard Society, The Elizabeth Fry Society, Saint John Newcomers Association, and the Family Resource Centre). It was a great opportunity to showcase Stone's central role in the city and to be reminded of the incredible people and organizations we have around us that are dedicating themselves to serving others. Central Saint John Community Ministry:

We've been asked to give a bit of an update on what we have been up to since we haven't provided anything recently. Terence continues to see growth in his English Language Bible Study with people coming from all over the globe. He has also been meeting with groups to talk about the Emmaus Way program which helps provide support for those going through a difficult time. Jasmine has taken 2 big training courses (Adverse Childhood Experiences training and Sexual Assault Crisis Intervention Training) to be better equipped at handling difficult disclosures. Terence and Jasmine worked on organizing the grade 8 class tour of the city. Jasmine also started a program at the Boys and Girls Club to help them learn about how they can be engaging in the community in a positive way. We continue to offer our drop-in programs both at Trinity church and at the Brunswick Court seniors residence and we engage in the community through teaching English classes (Terence), packing groceries for the Food Purchasing Club (Jasmine) and partnering on projects where we can. Please continue to pray for our work that it would bring others into the light of Christ.
