If anyone would like to join us for prayer and quiet meditation before the service from 9:30-9:55 am you may join us in the library. All are welcome to attend.



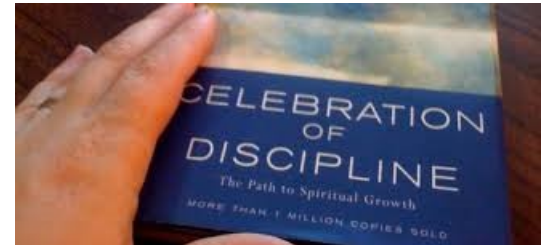
Living Like Jesus: Monday Evening Spiritual Practices

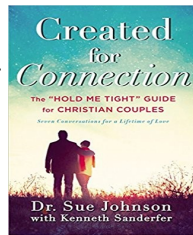
Meeting God in *The Shack* - Sat., October 28 - 10:00 am - 1:00 pm
